Recipes

Green Onion Salad

3 bunches green onions
2 hard boiled eggs
1 cup mayo
1 Sleeve Saltine crackers

Chop up onions and eggs. Mix together and then add the Mayo and mix some more. Add the crackers last and eat right away so that they are still crisp and do not get mushy.

I try to sample all the recipes before I pass them on and this one was great.....even got both of my kids to eat it.

I also got an interesting tip for saving green onions if you can't eat them right away. You chop them up and then put them in a clean pop or soft drink bottle and put it in the freezer. When you need some for a recipe just take it out and sprinkle out whatever amount you need.

Directions on For Pick-Up
